*Reflecting on the past, focusing on the future!*

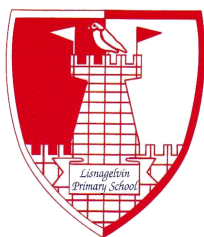

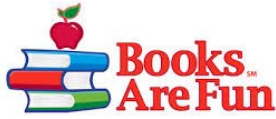
### Fundraiser for Oxford Bulls
