Some extra practice at home would be appreciated — it is important to learn the correct formation as soon as possible.


Shared reading

Physical Development

Phonological awareness

In class we are doing lots of work on early reading skills. We will be focusing on words that rhyme. Play rhyming games including nonsense words to develop your child's awareness of rhyme.

Home Learning Tip

Now we are beginning to practise some letters and numbers in school, remember to encourage your child to have a go at scribbling, colouring, drawing, painting, writing at home too. And remember all children will be at different stages — give lots of praise! Whatever stage he/she is at, each child will be making progress and always responds well to encouragement.



Number

We will revise the numbers 1 – 6
Sorting, counting, identifying more, less and the same as, will be practised with a Christmas theme.
