### Free School Meals & Uniform Allowance Process 2022/2023

The Education Authority will be issuing communications on the EA website and social media channels to inform parents/guardians of the process for the coming year. I would encourage all potential applicants to apply for support before the **30th June**, to ensure all is in place for the new school year in September. **If your application is not processed by September, payment for the school dinner will be required by school until the application has been received.** All parents/guardians (including new applicants) will be able to apply **online from week commencing 6th June 2022 via the following link :-** <https://www.eani.org.uk/financial-help/free-school-meals-uniform-grants>
