Topics in Maths

Number

- Continue to use addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.
- Identify coins and use money in calculations.
- Work out change to be given.

Area

- Calculate the area by counting squares.
- Use formula length x breadth to calculate the area of rectangles.

Length

- Use cm, m to measure lengths.
- Calculate the perimeter of a given shape.

Shape

- Recognise symmetry in shapes.
- Complete and draw symmetrical pictures.
- 2D shapes including hexagon, pentagon and octagon.

Direction

- Follow and give directions using the correct language including left/right turns, clockwise and anticlockwise.
- Use the eight points of the compass.
- Follow and plot coordinates on a grid.

Data Handling

- Construct and interpret graphs.
- Venn diagrams and Carroll diagrams.

Topics in English

- Looking at characters, plot and setting in stories especially futuristic settings and issues/dilemmas in stories.
- Read, write, compare and contrast poems.

Reading

Through shared, guided and at home.

- Read with increasing fluency, expression and comprehension.
- Answering questions from a variety of texts.
- Discuss plot, storyline and character developments.
- Predict what happens next in the story.
- Finding information and speech in texts.

Grammar

- Basic punctuation including full stops and capital letters.
- Use of comma.
